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## Communication for Behavioural Impact (COMBI) in Social Development Projects (6 – 8 August 2025) at NIRDPR Campus, Hyderabad.

Many communication initiatives in social development projects—whether in health, education, drinking water, or sanitation—have traditionally centred on **Information**, **Education**, **and Communication** (**IEC**) to improve awareness. While these efforts have helped 'inform' communities, they often fall short when it comes to achieving **sustained behavioural change**.

In recent years, **Behaviour Change Communication (BCC)** has gained prominence as a more focused approach. However, in practice, BCC is often reduced to repackaged IEC campaigns, lacking the strategic rigour needed to address the underlying drivers of behaviour.

This training on Communication for Behavioural Impact (COMBI) offers a deeper, more systematic approach. Grounded in social psychology, behavioural science, and strategic communication planning, the programme is designed to equip professionals working in diverse social development sectors with the tools to design and implement interventions that result in measurable and lasting change.
